Pursuant to said appointment, we have examined the Drainage District's records, as recorded by the Cerro Gordo County Auditor, to establish the original intended assessment boundary of this District. Any lands previously not recorded within the boundary of this District but have been found to be receiving benefits from the facilities of this District. We have examined each quarter-quarter section or smaller tract of land and have classified each
