be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RE-SOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SU-PERVISORS OF CERRO GORDO COUNTY that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3), subject to the following procedures:

1. All applications to be reviewed under this resolution shall be filed with the Administrative Assistant to the Board of Supervisors.

2. All applications shall be reviewed by CG Public Health and Planning and Zoning Department prior to consideration by the Board of Supervisors. The Department of Public Health and Planning and Zoning Department shall file written reports with the Board of Supervisors prior to the meeting at which the application will be considered.
